

DELIGHTFUL BIKE RIDES THROUGH STYRIA'S NORTH.

Day 1: Genuine hospitality. The journey starts out at Castle Trautenfels. From here, your groups cycle along the river Enns to the Benedictine Abbey of Admont, home to the world's largest monastic library. Welcome cocktail and local dinner at the hotel. (37 km)

Day 2: Genuine insights. Accompanied by the river Mur, your groups ride along the Mur Cycle Path. Short stop in Bruck an der Mur for a guided city tour. Continuation and lunch break, subsequent tour at the Austrian Open-Air Museum Stübing. Glamorous alternative: Hat manufacturer Kepka. After cycling about 60 km, bus transfer back to the hotel.

Day 3: Genuine versatility. Today's tour sets out from the monastery in Neuberg. Along the river Mürz, your groups follow the cycle path to Mürzzuschlag. Here, they visit the WinterSportMuseum and marvel about the ski-jumping hills. Lunch break and continuation to the medieval Oberkapfenberg Castle. Via Bruck an der Mur your guests follow along the Mur Cycle Path back to the hotel. (72 km)

Day 4: Genuine sights. Starting out from the hotel, bike ride to the Red Bull Racing Ring in Spielberg. Along the way break at Seckau's monastery. In Spielberg, your groups cycle straight through the world-famous track to the visitor's



center. Continuation to the fascinating world of **Gemstones Krampl** with a guided tour there. Option to enjoy coffee and cake. At the end of the day, your guests rewind with a well-earned drink on the hotel's terrace. (65 km)

Day 5: Genuine strength. Along a 55 km long cycle tour, riders experience the exciting bridge forged between heavy industry and scenic mountain tops. Passing by furnaces to reach the Gösser Brewing Museum. On the way back, your guests may take a refreshing dip at Lake Traboch.

Day 6: Genuine coolness. The further your groups cycle into the valley, the more beautiful it gets on day six. Today's highlight: the picturesque lake **Grüner See** (Green Lake), nestled in between steep mountains. Your guests spend their lunch break here. Ride back to the hotel via Bruck an der Mur, where they may get some ice-cream as reward. (82 km)

Day 7: Genuine memories. After a hearty breakfast, the trip's last tour leads up the Erzberg. Later, your guests set out on their journey homewards, taking numerous delightful memories with them.

Culture & culinary art on the hike

DISCOVERIES ON THE TRAILS OF THE VOLCANOES AT A GENTLE PACE.

First stop upon arrival at the **Zotter chocolate factory**. On the tour it is endless chocolate for everybody. After this sweet treat it is time to check-in at the chosen hotel in the Thermen- and Vulkanland region. The first day concludes with a joint dinner at the hotel.

After breakfast your groups are welcomed by the lord of the manor at Castle Kornberg. The historic rooms come alive during a private guided tour, which is enhanced with interactive elements. From the castle's courtyard the hiking trail leads via the Himmel-Erden-Weg (Sky-Earth-Path) to ham manufacturer Vulcano. Guided tour and well-deserved snack with internationally recognized products. Continuation by bus to David Gölles. His house of whiskey, gin & rum is home to creative spirits, which your guests learn more about on a guided tour and tasting. (2,5 hrs)

On day three your groups head up to the impressive Riegersburg Castle with an inclined lift. Guided tour through the historic room and quarters. Option: Lunch break at the fortress' tavern for a vitalizing snack. From Riegersburg your groups hike along the Genussweg path through gentle landscape until they reach Gölles manufactory for delicious vinegars and fine liquors. (2 hrs)



Day four starts off with a walk up the viewing platform in Frutten-Gießelsdorf. From there, your groups set out on the trails of the volcanoes and hike through vineyards to Krispel Gourmet Estate. The guided tour forges a bridge from wine in basalt to free-range woolly pigs. Invigorated from a tasting of three Krispel wines and Neusetzer bacon with bread, the hike continues to Straden, a village sitting on a gentle hilltop. Bus transfer to Berghofer-mill, where your guests get a taste of Styria by experiencing a tour covering grain, pumpkin seed oil and power plant. (3 hrs)

On the last day breakfast and journey home. On request, a stop in the City of Delight Graz may be arranged.

Mur river bike tours

FROM THE RIVER'S SOURCE TO THE TIMBER REGION

Arrival by bus at the **river's rising** in Muhr. From the small exhibition showcased here, your groups cycle to the **Wood Museum**. A guided tour introduces timber in its versatility – then and now. After riding the last few kilometers to the hotel, your groups are **welcomed with a drink** and check-in. Social evening with dinner. (65 km)

The next day, breakfast is followed by a ride via the Mur Cycle Path to the Red Bull Racing Ring Spielberg. During the guided tour and subsequent lunch your guests enjoy views over the track. Transfer back by bus and dinner at hotel. (60 km)

FROM WORLD HERITAGE TO WORLD HERITAGE

Tour 1 takes your groups from Mürzsteg downstream along cycle path R5. Passing by Neuberg Abbey, they arrive in Mürzzuschlag, home to the Southern Railway Museum dedicated to UNESCO World Heritage Semmering Railway. Back at the hotel a visit at Oberkapfenberg Castle entices. Tour 2 leads from the hotel via R5 to Bruck an der Mur. From there, the Mur Cycle Path (R2) meanders through the quaint cities Frohnleiten and Deutschfeistritz to the Austrian Open-Air Museum Stübing. (42 km) Unique world-wide, it showcases historic architecture from all over Austria. Alternative: Prolong the ride until Graz (74 km) with its UNESCO World Heritage Historic Center and Castle Eggenberg. Both tours leave time for further exploring along the way.

STARTING OUT IN GRAZ

Set off after check-in: Along the river Mur your groups cycle through green nature to Hat manufacturer Kepka. A tour through the crazy world of hat making awaits. Return to the Capital of Delight Graz via the Mur Cycle Path for spare time in the city. (46 km) Vitalized from breakfast, day 2 starts with a bike ride to Southern-Styrian Labugger Kürbiskernölpresse, a pumpkin seed oil mill. Guided tour and traditional scrambled eggs with pumpkin seed oil. Continuation to wine tavern Buschenschank Schneeberger for a genial wine tasting and guided tour. Your group concludes the visit with an extensive cold platter. Bus transfer back to Graz. (52 km)

Active biking days

CYCLING ALONG THE RIVER ENNS IN-BETWEEN THE DACHSTEIN GLACIER AND THE LOW TAUERN.

Day 1: With a Styrian "Griaß eich" a warm welcome is extended to your guests upon arrival. If arriving before 14.00 o'clock, set out from Flachauwinkel via the Enns Cycle Path to Schladming. Along the way stop at Steiner 1888 World of Wool in Mandling for a guided tour. Option: Coffee and cake. Continuation to the hotel and dinner. (50 km)

Day 2: Excursion by bike to Liezen, the district's capital. From there your groups continue to the Benedictine Abbey of Admont with a visit and guided tour incl. the world's largest monastic library. Impressive mountain ranges as well as the rush of the river Enns serve as scenic background while riding along. Transfer back by bus. (80 km)

Day 3: By bus your groups head towards the Styrian Salz-kammergut for a tour of the lake area. With the Fischerei Ausseerland a delightful and informative fishery lures cyclers to stop by. Or they head on a boat tour on lake Grundlsee with the nostalgic Schifffahrt Grundlsee. (55 km)

Day 4: On the penultimate day your groups start out from the hotel. Via the Enns Cycle Path, they reach Schladming and head up the world-famous Planai mountain by gondola (incl. their bikes). Option: Lunch break at the rustic Schafalm. From the cable car's halfway station your guests bike to the Untertal valley. From there, a short hike leads to the waterfall Riesachwasserfall. Subsequent ride back through the Talbachklamm gorge to the hotel. (36 km)

ALTERNATIVE Day 4, if staying at Hoteldorf Stocker:

According to the motto "bike & hike" your groups set out by bike from Schladming-Rohrmoos to Untertal valley. After a short hike they reach the waterfall Riesachwasserfall. They journey onwards by bike again: Following the path through the valley to get to the valley's head, where furnaces confirm that the mining industry was at home here ones. Pleasant breaks and stories accompany your groups. There is also enough time for culinary stops.

Day 5: After breakfast your groups say goodbye and take stunning memories about their adventurous days in the Schladming Dachstein region with them.


